MEET OUR KEYNOTE SPEAKER

LT. GENERAL KENNETH DAHL

COMMANDING GENERAL, INSTALLATION MANAGEMENT COMMAND, U.S. ARMY

Served as deputy commanding general for I Corps, Ft. Lewis, WA. Joined I Corps following a one-year deployment to Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan--served as deputy commanding general (CG)-support, US Forces Afghanistan and also commander of US National Support Element.

Served previously as deputy CG for support for 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry), Fort Drum, NY. Deployed with 10th Mountain Division HQ to Kandahar, Afghanistan, as deputy commanding general for support & stability for Regional Command South.

Served in the Pentagon on the Joint Staff, J-5 as Assistant Deputy Director for Political Military Affairs, Middle East; & also in J-3 as the Deputy Director for Operations (Team 4) in the National Military Command Center.

Completed a Federal Executive Fellowship at the Brookings Institution-- focused his efforts on U.S. government interagency reform.

Commanded the 212th Field Artillery Brigade, Fort Sill OK and deployed to Iraq and served as commander of the Joint Area Support Group Central, Multi-National Force-Iraq.

Served in the 3rd Infantry Division in Germany, 2nd Infantry Division in Korea, 82nd Airborne Division at Fort Bragg, North Carolina, and 25th Infantry Division in Hawaii.

Graduate of U.S. Military Academy class of 1982, holds a Master of Arts degree in Social Psychology from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, and a Master of Arts in National Security and Strategic Studies from the U.S. Naval War College.

Served as a National Security Fellow in the Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University.
